The Priory and Parish Church of St Mary, Lancaster

Lancaster Priory as it is more commonly known - overlooks the centre of Lancaster. It is situated adjacent to Lancaster Castle in a conservation area with stunning views across Morecambe Bay to the Lakeland Hills. The church is a Grade 1 listed building, located on a site which has seen Christian worship since Saxon times. The Priory has recently received a 'Child Friendly Church' award and a 'Marque of Excellence' awarded by the North-West Multi-Faith Tourism Association in recognition of Lancaster Priory's ministry of welcome to visitors.
